■ **SAN ISIDRO, Nueva Ecija:** The National Transmission Corporation has entered into an agreement with the local police to intensify the campaign against the theft of power cables and other parts of equipment owned by the firm. Senior Inspector Francisco G. Mateo, chief of San Isidro police, said the memorandum of agreement included massive information dissemination on Republic Act 7832, transmission line safety and anti-power pilferage law. The expensive, mostly imported power cable materials were being sold at very low price to junkshops. The police vowed to file charges against anyone who would be caught buying or selling the said hot items.
